



SUMMER EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Kananaskis Country Campgrounds operates 50 campgrounds with over 2000 campsites and 3 stores, located throughout 5 valleys of Kananaskis Country, in the Rocky Mountains. We are seeking highly motivated, hard working individuals to fill summer staffing positions. These positions are expected to run from either early May or mid-June to early September or mid-October and are full-time seasonal positions. Perfect for outdoor enthusiasts wanting to spend the summer in the Rocky Mountains!

Positions:

1. **Store Clerks:** Working in one of our store centres, the clerk will be responsible for retail sales of food products and camping supplies, making campground reservations, answering phone inquiries, providing visitor information, checking-in campers, stocking shelves, cash handling, store opening and closing, serving scooped ice cream, processing rentals of outdoor equipment (canoes, kayaks, bikes), cleaning, and other duties as assigned. Experience in a retail setting would be an asset. Strong communication, time management, and customer service skills are required. Suitable candidates should have computer proficiency and cash handling experience. Experience with outdoor recreation equipment (bikes, canoes, etc) is an asset but not required.
2. **Maintenance Workers:** Responsible for the cleaning and upkeep of all buildings and facilities. May also be involved with revenue collection and firewood sales to the public. Will complete special projects as assigned. This is an outdoor position that requires the individual to oftentimes work in an independent fashion without direct supervision. An efficient, hard-working person with strong communication skills is required. A valid class 5 license is required. Experience with small equipment and driving truck & trailer is an asset and should be identified in your application.

3. Campground Managers: Seeking mature individuals to work in selected campgrounds within Kananaskis Country. This position is a full-time summer seasonal position and would require the successful candidates to reside in a campground, in their own RV. Responsible for revenue collection, firewood sales, campsite and washroom cleaning and maintenance, interacting with the public to provide information and to ensure camper compliance and safety. Staff accommodations are not available for campground managers. You must have your own RV.

Successful applicants should be comfortable living and working in a mountain park setting, away from city/town life.
