Available Positions:

1. Maintenance Workers: Responsible for the cleaning and upkeep of all buildings and facilities. May also be involved with revenue collection and firewood sales to the public. Will complete special projects as assigned. This is an outdoor position that requires the individual to oftentimes work in an independent fashion without direct supervision. An efficient, hard-working person with strong communication skills is required. A valid class 5 license is required. Accommodations are available.

2. Store Clerks: Working in our store centre, the clerk will be responsible for retail sales of food products, camping supplies, taking campground reservations and other duties as assigned.
